Clerkship Directors in Internal Medicine

The Clerkship Directors in Internal Medicine (CDIM) is the professional organization for those responsible for the teaching of internal medicine to medical students in the United States and Canada. CDIM members are internal medicine clerkship directors, clerkship administrators, sub-internship directors, course directors and key faculty of clinically related courses during the pre-clinical years (e.g. Introduction to Clinical Medicine, Physical Diagnosis) as well as directors and key faculty for internal medicine electives and capstone courses during the clinical years. CDIM has a broad, talented and engaged group of undergraduate medical educators and coordinators who are dedicated to excellence across all four years of medical school.

CDIM offers tremendous value through networking with leaders in academic internal medicine who focus on undergraduate medical education, research, and patient care. CDIM is a founding member of the Alliance for Academic Internal Medicine (AAIM), a consortium of five academically-focused internal medicine organizations, including the Association of Program Directors in Internal Medicine, the Association of Professors in Internal Medicine, the Association of Subspecialty Professors in Internal Medicine, and the Association of Administrators in Internal Medicine.

CDIM meets annually during Academic Internal Medicine Week, next scheduled for March 2017. In addition, CDIM offers a broad array of programming for members, including the annual AAIM Skills Development Conference, CDIM and AAIM-level committee work on medical education, and monthly webinar series produced by CDIM members.
