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T2- I check the NLM catalog to see if the journal is indexed in MEDLINE( not just present inPubMed) -example for @AcadMedJournal: <https://t.co/61KipXjgv1> - indexed since 1989 #MedEdChat



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T2- use @thinkchecksub to evaluate a journal -also remember #impactfactors can be manipulated or even disappear ( I would not use #impactfactors) #MedEdChat

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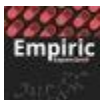

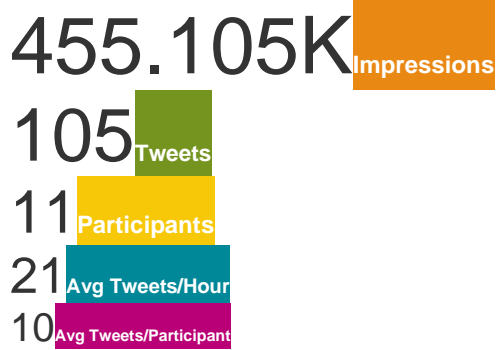
