Education Research

- Similar format and requirements to Research Article @Neurology Author Center:
 - ≤4500 words
 - Structured abstract (≤350 words)
 - ≤50 references
 - ≤7 figures or tables
- IMRD format
- Focus: education research interventions including quantitative, qualitative and mixed methods studies, randomized and controlled studies, pre/post-intervention designs, and other research studies of educational interventions
- * Word count exceptions *may* be considered for qualitative studies

Education Research – Curriculum Innovations

- Same format as Education Research. This is a special subcategory of Education Research article.
- Focus: these articles will include new and innovative curriculum or other educational programs for learners at any point on the educational spectrum including pipeline learners, undergraduate students, medical and other health professions students, biomedical students (e.g., post-doc or Ph.D.), residents or fellows, and faculty or practicing providers
- Articles structured as:
 - *Introduction & Problem Statement*
 - *Objectives*
 - *Methods & Curriculum Description*
 - *Results & Assessment Data*
 - *Discussion & Lessons Learned*

Logistics

- No article processing fee
- Online-only journal
- Continuous publication
- Issues compiled 2-4 times/year
